

## Instructions for Using the BBQ's

Most of our barbeques are connected to a natural gas service. A few use propane.

### Starting the BBQ

**Natural Gas:** Turn on the before using the BBQ. To the burner valve to high, a flame appears.

- Please turn off gas valve next to wall after use. NOTE: It is your responsibility to clean the BBQ and BBQ tools after using them and replace the BBQ cover.
- SOME units have propane BBQ tanks that are provided free of charge. If you run out of propane, please let us know immediately.
